



MAIN APPLICATIONS

Riblene FM 53 F BA is recommended for automatic packaging where low gauge films having a certain rigidity and gloss are required (hygienic packaging). Films manufactured by Riblene FM 53 F BA are easily heat shrinkable.

PROCESSING NOTES

Riblene FM 53 F BA is easily processable using blown film technology. Melt temperature should be between 150 °C and 170 °C. Recommended thickness: 18 - 50 µm.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

Riblene FM 53 F BA is supplied in pellet form. This material may readily be conveyed and bulk fed through equipment designed for conventional pelletized polyethylene resin, provided the equipment is designed to prevent accumulation of the fines and dust particles that are contained in all polyethylene resins. These fines and dust particles can, under certain conditions, pose an explosion hazard. We recommend that the conveying system used be equipped with filters of adequate size, operated and maintained in such a manner to ensure that no leaks develop and earthed adequately. We further recommend that good housekeeping should be practiced throughout your facility. The product should be stored in dry conditions at temperatures below 50 °C and protected from sunlight. Improper storage can initiate degradation which results in odor generation, color changes and can have negative effects on the physical properties of the product. Before using this product, it is recommended to read and understand the relevant Safety Data Sheet.
